
















The first Tesla combined American ingenuity with British coachwork

Any opinion on Tesla is, well, complicated. But the company's first car was decidedly more straightforward. Before the Model S, assembly lines in a tent, or the Cybertruck, Tesla's first car was based on the Lotus Elise. By taking the bones of the British Roadster and converting it to electric drive, Tesla could prove the feasibility of a long-range EV, without the added complexity of engineering an entire car. And the Elise served as an excellent starting point, with a feathery curb weight (under 2,000 pounds in gas-powered form) and excellent ride and handling characteristics. It was a such a good idea that Dodge even floated a similar idea with the Circuit EV concept car in 2009.





As with its current models, Tesla made several running improvements to the Roadster over its four-year, 2,500-unit production run. The 2010 Tesla Roadster for sale on Hemmings.com, our latest Find of the Day, has an updated interior compared to earlier Roadsters, with a small digital screen that delivers real-time charge and range data. According to the listing, this example is one of collector John McMullen's cars, and he is cutting back on his fleet. With only 1,019 miles on the Tesla's odometer, it's clear he had too many other options to get this car out on the road.

And, come to think of it, the Tesla Roadster is a 21st-century variation on a recurring theme in classic cars: British Coachwork juiced up with American power. Only instead of a V-8, it's an electric motor and lithium-ion battery packs. Does this future- (or arguably already-) collectible get you charged up, would you rather have one of the other Teslas for sale in the Hemmings Classifieds, or does this make you go back to the source and want to browse Lotus cars on the market?
